## 10 IEP QUESTIONS TO ASK

**DRAFT** copies-Request Draft copies (*in writing*) of proposed IEP, testing and all reports at least one week ahead of the meeting.

**DATA**-Your new IEP should have updated PRESENT LEVELS of data. IF you don't see data, request it.

**BEHAVIOR**-If the team has any concerns about non-compliance, on/off task behavior, get data before decisions.

**ACCOMMODATIONS & MODIFICATIONS**-Read this section carefully and make sure there is a plan for implementation in all classes.

**PLACEMENT**-Be sure you fully understand your student's placement and the daily schedule to accompany it.

**CLASSROOM MANAGEMENT**-Ask for classroom management plan. Are incentives used? If so, which ones? Is it individualized? Is there a <u>separate class vs. school management program</u>?

**MINUTES**-How will minutes be used? Pull out? Push in? Consult? Know how/when/where minutes will be used.

**DATA COLLECTION**-How will the team collect data for the IEP and how will it be shared with you?

**COMMUNICATION**-What is the preferred method (email, phone, etc..) of communication for each team member?

**DAILY COMMUNICATION**-How will daily activity be reported to you at home? Communication log? Email? Chart? Graph?

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
